You May Be Eligible For Abortion Services at No Cost if You Have Illinois Medicaid Coverage or You Are Eligible For Coverage and Willing to Apply For Medicaid

Illinois Medicaid now provides full coverage for abortion services. Women will now be able to have an abortion procedure even if they do not have the resources to pay for the service.

If you are currently enrolled in Illinois Medicaid please just bring in your picture ID and Medicaid card and we will be able to provide abortion care for you. You will not have to pay anything for care related to your abortion including sedation, medications, lab testing, ultrasound, or RhoGAM if you have a negative blood type.

If you are not currently enrolled in Illinois Medicaid you do not have to wait until you receive your Medicaid card in the mail to come in for your procedure. You can bring in a printout showing that you have submitted an application or take a picture and show it to our staff. We have included links below to help you see if you qualify for Illinois Medicaid and apply online for coverage. Once you have applied and you have qualified you will not have to pay anything for care related to your abortion including sedation, medications, lab testing, ultrasound, or RhoGAM if you have a negative blood type.

What Will I Need to Bring to My Appointment?

- You must bring in proof of current Medicaid eligibility or documentation that you have applied for coverage to the office on the day of your visit. You can email the document(s) to <u>healthcenter@officegci.com</u>.
